I am very pleased to share our experiences and accomplishments of ASHA for Children Foundation in the year 2079. This year, I can gladly announce that we were successfully able to run a school, Asha Shiksha Sadan at Chittapol Bhaktapur with furnished classrooms. All thanks to our donors, staff, friends and family who have constantly supported us and made a distant dream come true. We are running classes from Play-group to Class 4. Our ASHA for children family is joined by 71 children; 36 kids are sponsored and come from the nearby orphanages whereas the rest of the 35 are local, non-sponsored children. We have a total of 11 teaching staff and 10 non teaching staff. A huge thank you to both our teaching and non teaching staff as they work hard each day in making ASHA for children is not just a school but a safe and encouraging space for our children.

Our team has already set our goals for the coming year. Our plan for the next year is to open our doors to even more needy children and provide them a home. We also plan to extend our classes up to grade 5. Vocational training for children above 18 years and for the women in the community will be provided, to empower them individually.

We are obliged to Nepal Himalaya Park Stiftung, Germany for their regular support for our program. Further we are grateful to our other donor and volunteer who made their valuable support!

Also, I would like to thank the children, their parents, Manab Kalyan Samaj(Nalinchowk) and Tulasalaya Ashram (Changunarayan) for adapting to our teaching learning environment and trusting us.

We are running a school, Asha Shiksha Sadan since 1st Jestha, 2079 (15th May, 2022) at Chittapol-10, Suryabinayak, Bhaktapur.

OUR ACHIEVEMENT

Asha For Children Foundation is delighted to announce the commencement of our new school, Asha Shiksha Sadan.



We are successfully running the school, **Asha Shiksha Sadan** with new enthusiasm to fulfill a gap between rich and poor people in the country. Our Principal, 10 teachers, and 10 non teaching staffs provide quality education to our 71 children in the safe school environment. Out of them, 36 are the underprivileged children and 35 are the local children.

Montessori based Pre-primary classes and primary class upto 5 are facilitated with different educational materials.

PRE-PRIMARY TEACHER TRAINING

On Magh of this year, we gave all our teachers a pre-primary teacher training which was conducted by Ms. Narayani Koirala. This training helped our teachers to conduct daily classes and interactions with children of age group 2- 12 years, on how to make classrooms a creative space and also gave knowledge on child psychology.





OUR GOALS FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR

Hostels for underprivileged children

We plan to run the hostels for underprivileged children the coming fiscal year. Here the kids will be provided with good food and great environment to grow.





Expand our classes to Grade 5

We are prepared to expand our classrooms up to Grade 5 by this coming fiscal year. Teacher trainings and course materials are being prepared accordingly.



Vocational trainings are important to empower children as this prepares them to be independent. Thus, this coming fiscal year we want to be able to at least give two vocational trainings to our students above 18 years old.





Conduct women empowerment trainings for the women in the community

An empowered women can bring significant change in a community. so, we want to give various trainings that will help in empowering women such as sewing and knitting!


